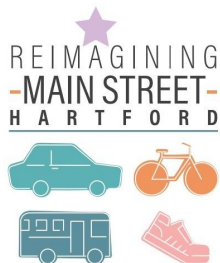
### Special Application for Outdoor Commercial Space
